

# Appendix 3: Member attendance for all Board members from 1916 until 1939

It should be noted that the number of Board meetings during this period was severely reduced. Members were only required to attend, on average, one meeting every six weeks.

Note: no attendance details for Ross are included, as he was replaced immediately after his appointment.
