In 1790, *The Universal British Directory of Trade and Commerce*¹ identified 11 piano makers, five harpsichord makers, 10 organ builders, 15 musical instrument makers and 17 music sellers residing in London.

Each entry given in the list below is worded and italicised according to its appearance in *The Universal British Directory of Trade and Commerce*.
