2023年，中國也迎來了許多其它的『新時代』。儘管2022年底的疫情解封引發了人們對國家以及生活能夠回歸正軌的期待，然而2023年中國經濟卻依然面對著房地產行業的持續困境、創紀錄的失業率以及地方政府債務危機的衝擊。在全球範圍內，中國政府推出了一系列全新的、雄心勃勃的外交舉措來吸引全球南方的支持以便擴大其在世界舞臺上的發言權。《中國故事年鑒2023：中國新時代》對以上這些及其它重要事件提供了深入的剖析。想必在未來幾年中這些事件會持續發酵並彰顯，引發更多關注。
